This club is a lunchtime club for any child in Key Stage Two. Mrs Nixon and Mrs Weston will lead this club.

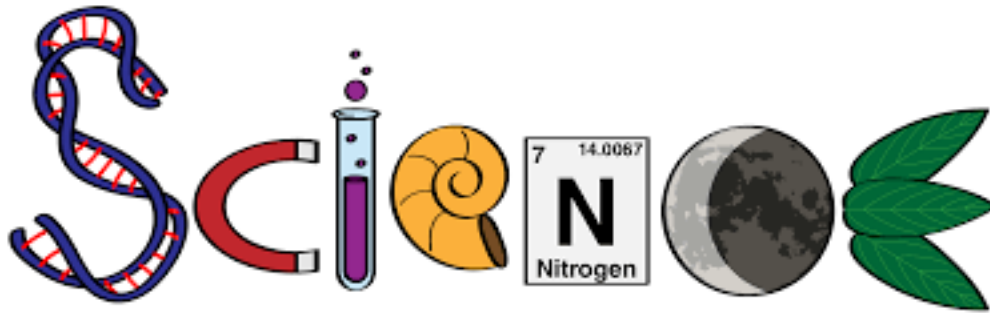
It will include opportunities to: draw and colour; practise breathing exercises; calming strategies and meditation.

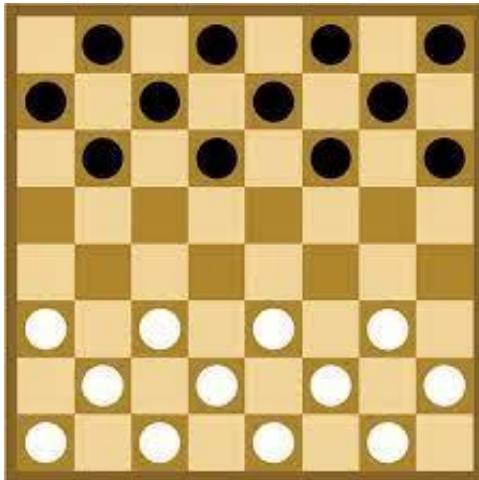
Please pick up your child from the front of school at 4pm.
