Headteacher Messages

Mrs Clarkson will also be leaving us and, I am sure, you will take the opportunity to say goodbye as she has been our Year 1 teacher for five years so most of your children would have had their good foundations of learning delivered by her.

We have been so proud of your children this year. I am currently writing my Headteacher comments on their reports and they make wonderful reading — you will receive them in July. The children have really begun to thrive with the new curriculum and their strong phonics. Breakfast and After School Club September 2023

The Trust have heavily subsidised school dinners this year and we are now in a position where this can no longer happen. We are currently in negotiation with Chartwells to review prices, however, the indication is that there will be an increase to prices in September. I will let you know as far in advance as possible, what this price will look like. Your child can still bring in their own packed lunch if this is your preference.

Barrier Arm

The new barrier will be fully operational at the end of this week to ensure safety on the driveway. Please only come up the driveway if you are a 'blue badge holder' and have agreed permission.

Playground
