<u>Uniform Support</u>

<u>Head- lice Alert</u>

Head lice are tiny insects that vary in colour from cream to brown/black. Small eggs are laid by the head lice. They are the size of a grain of salt, yellow-white in colour, and are found glued to the hair near the scalp. They are usually found behind the ears, the back of the neck and fringe.

To assist us in the prevention of head lice spreading please ensure you check your child/ren's hair. If head lice or nits are found please treat immediately.

Recent advice suggests:

✓ Eggs can be treated EVERY NIGHT with conditioner (15- 25p for a large green bottle from Asda), combing through with a nit comb;

✓ Keep long hair tied back and preferably plaited;

- ✓ Don't forget to treat your own hair;
- ✓ Wash pillow cases regularly.
